Kindergarten is a program for children in the year prior to starting primary school.

Why Kindergarten?

- ✎ Kindergarten gives children the opportunity to grow and develop through PLAY – the way children learn best.
- ✎ Encourages and stimulates children's development socially, emotionally, intellectually and physically.
- ✎ Allows children to explore the environment, whilst developing their independence, confidence and self esteem.
- ✎ Kindergarten assists children with their transition to school.
