Kindergarten is a program for children in the year prior to starting primary school.

Why Kindergarten?

- ✧ Kindergarten gives children the opportunity to grow and develop through PLAY – the way children learn best.
- ✧ Encourages and stimulates children's development socially, emotionally, intellectually and physically.
- ✧ Allows children to explore the environment, whilst developing their independence, confidence and self esteem.
